



Annual catch




- The Pacific saury was first developed in 2004, but the full fishery data was from 2013

Number of vessels




- The number of active vessels increased to 4 in 2015, and it has been stabilized the same

Accumulated catch in recent years




was the lowest in recent years

Seasonal catch in recent years




2021 was the lowest in recent years

In general, the fishing grounds were between 165 degree and 170 degree east longitude in the early fishing season, then shifted to the west. After October, the main fishing grounds were in the west of 160 degree east longitude.
