

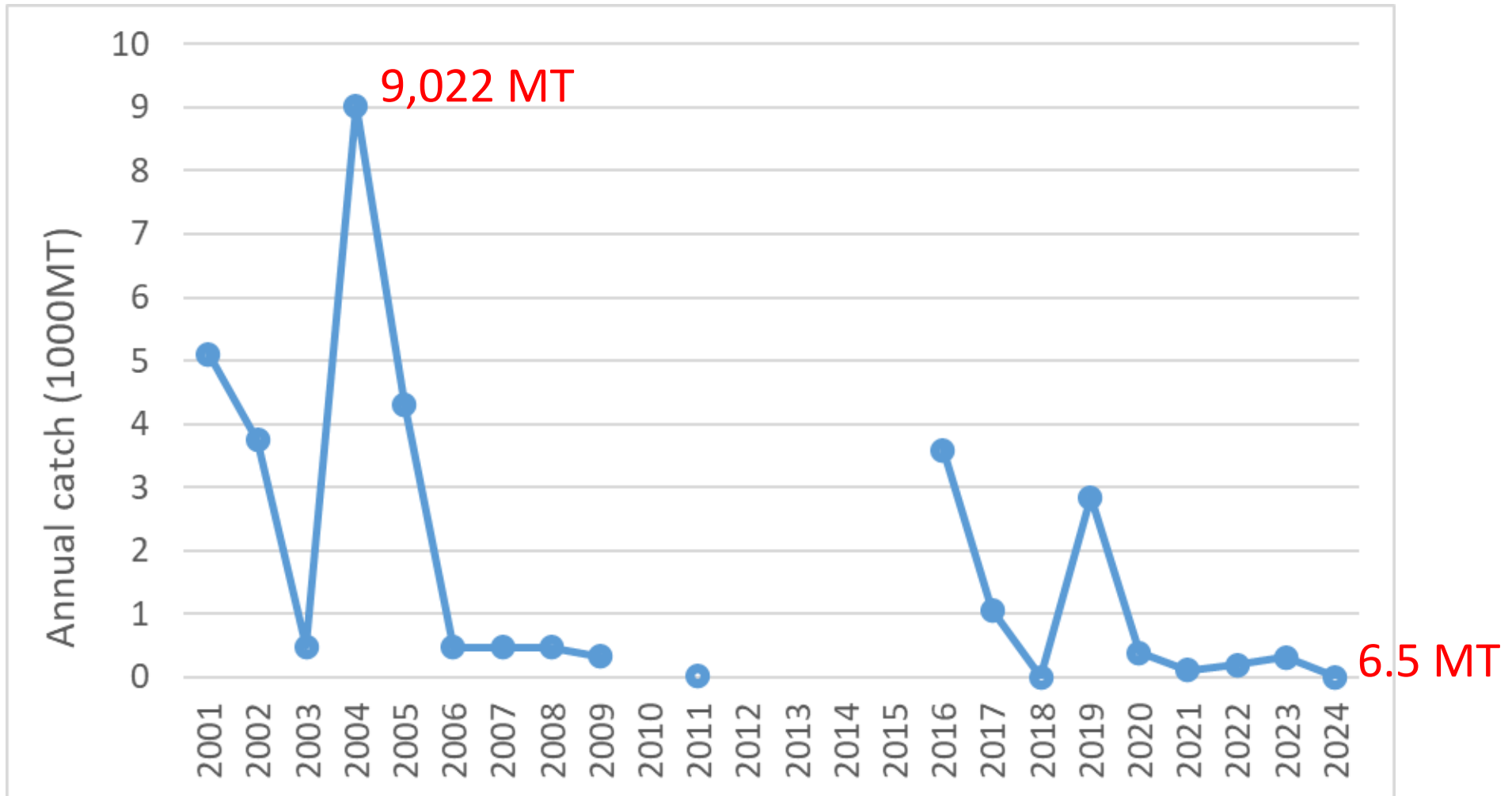

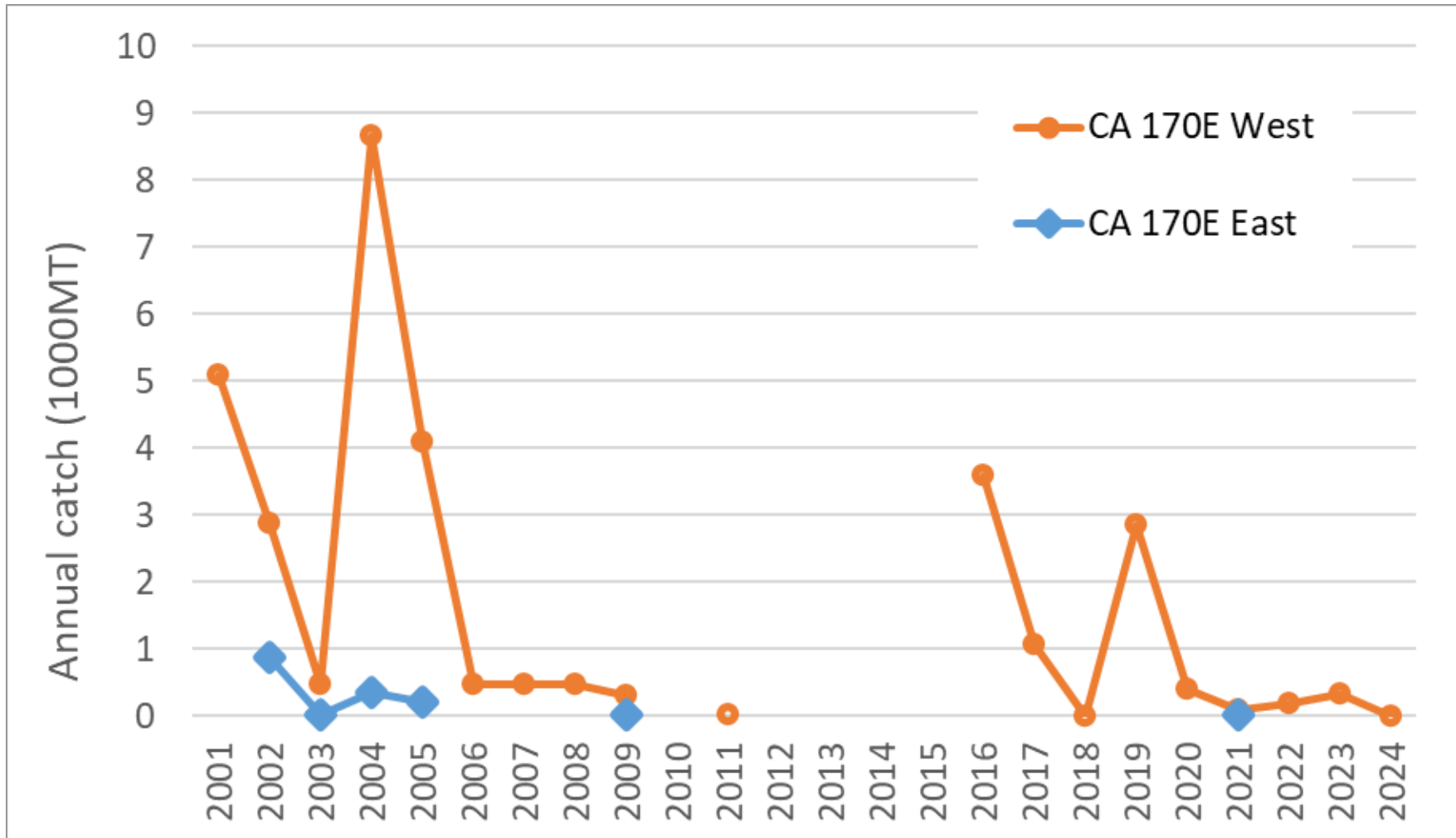


Annual catch series



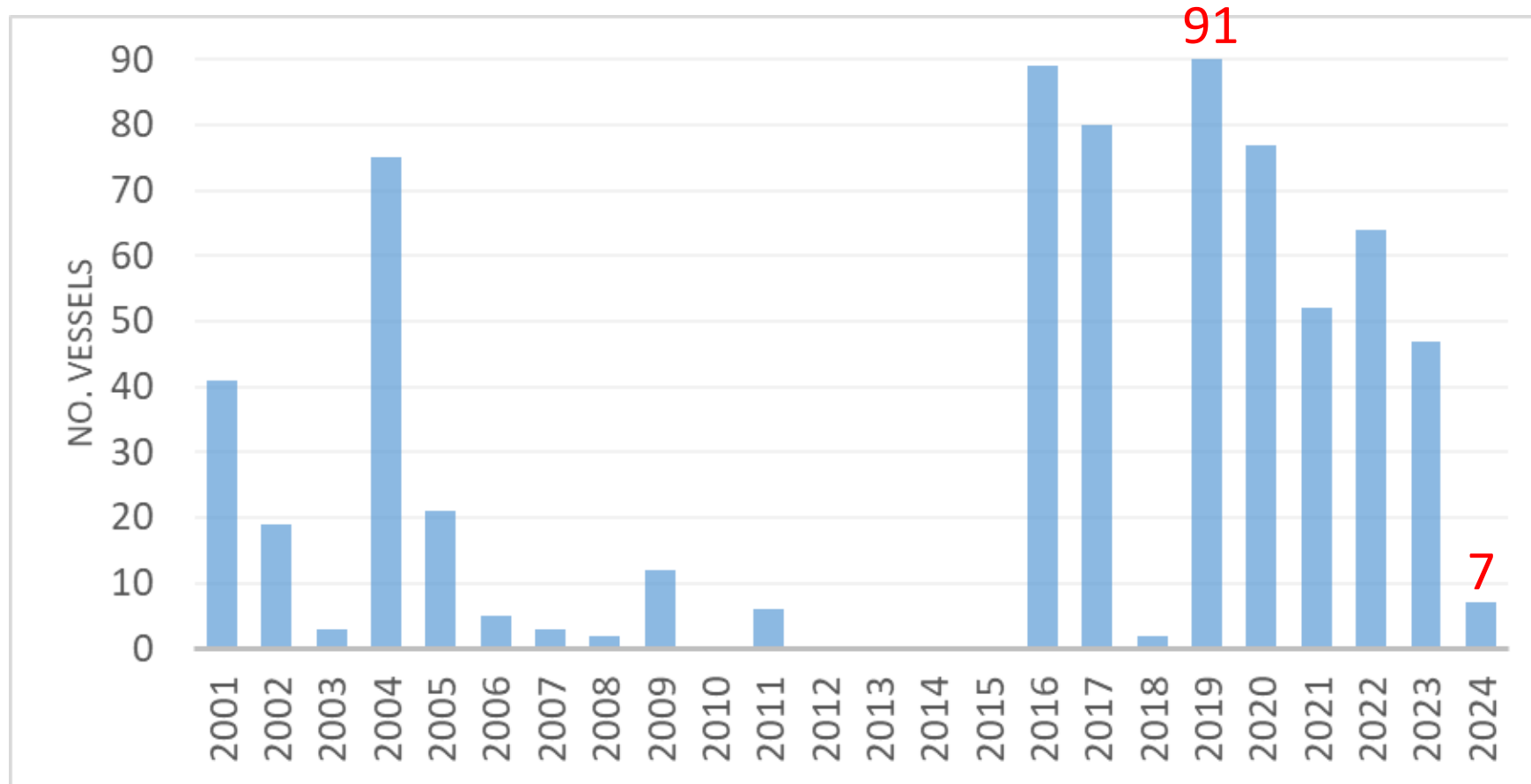
- The catch peaked in 2004

Annual catch by area



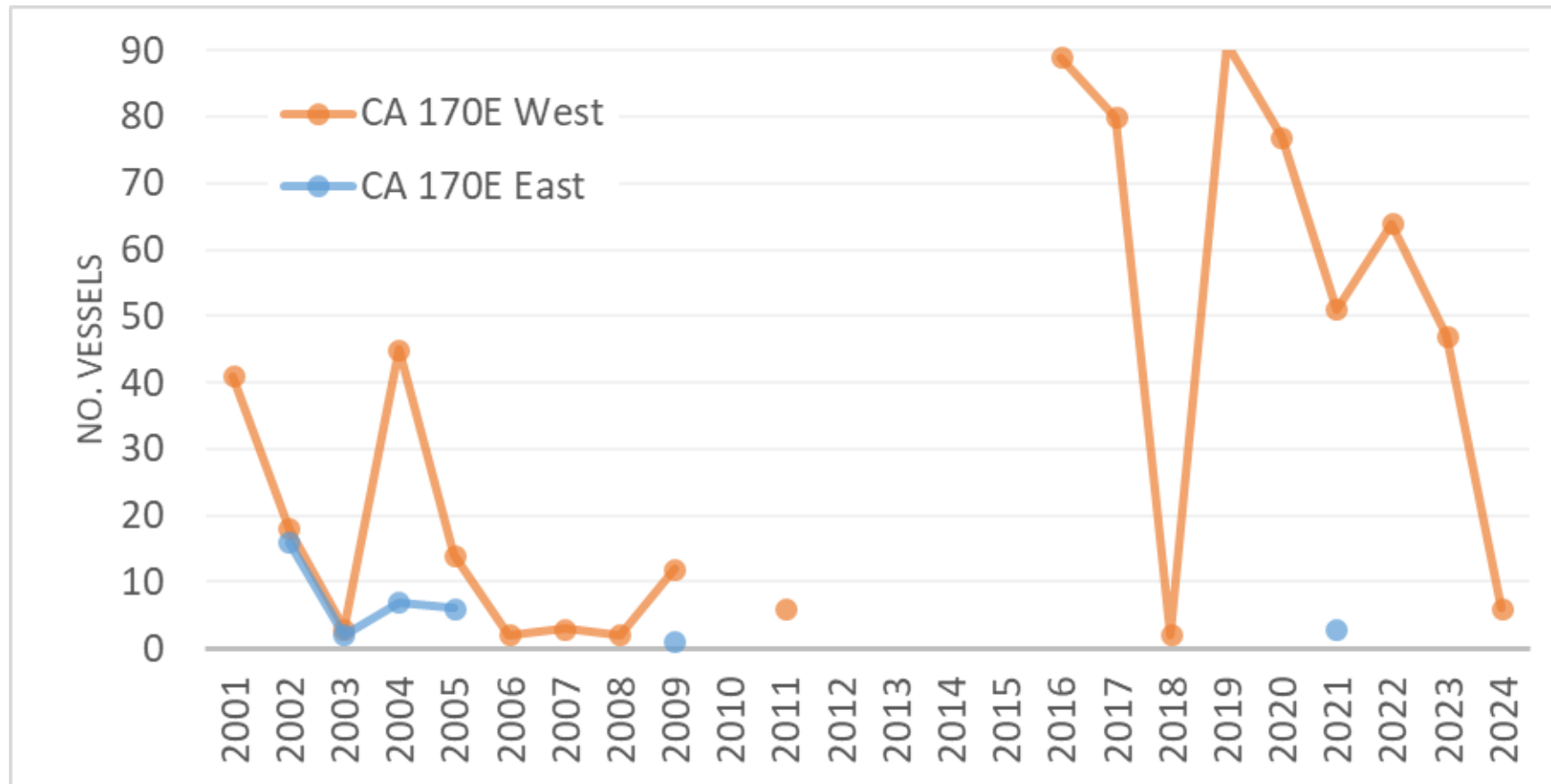
- The catch is mainly from western region

Number of vessels



- There were 91 vessels in 2019
- Only seven vessels harvested squid in 2024

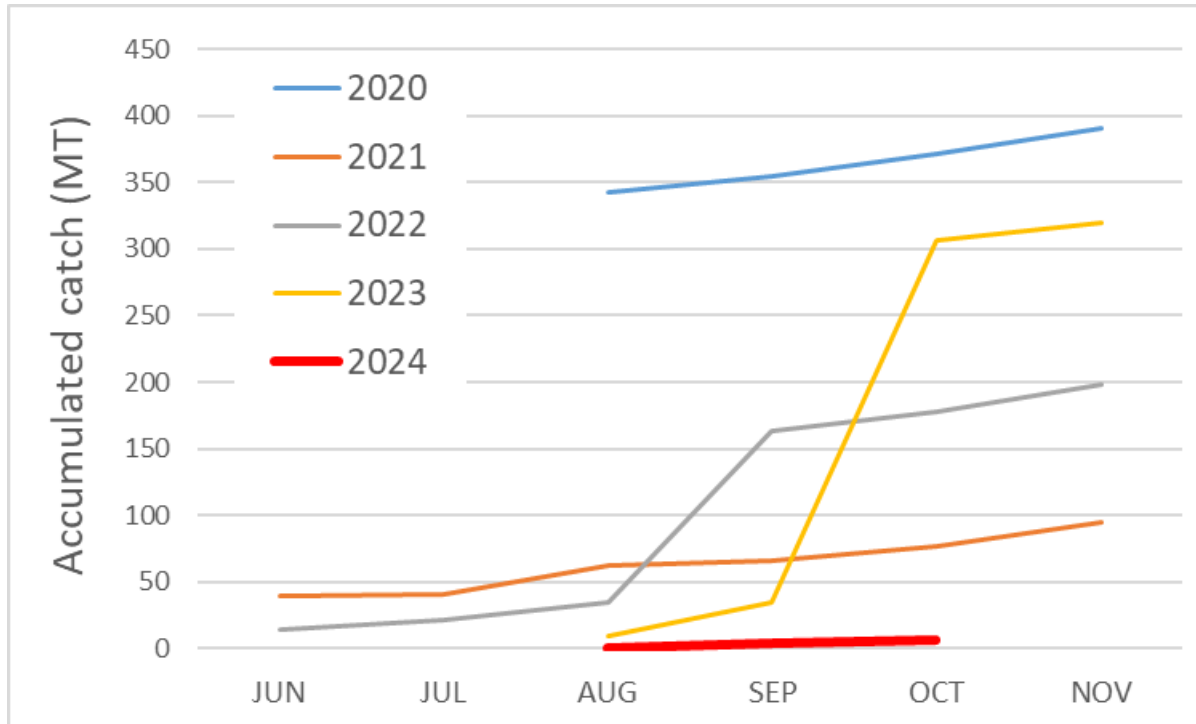
Number of vessels by area



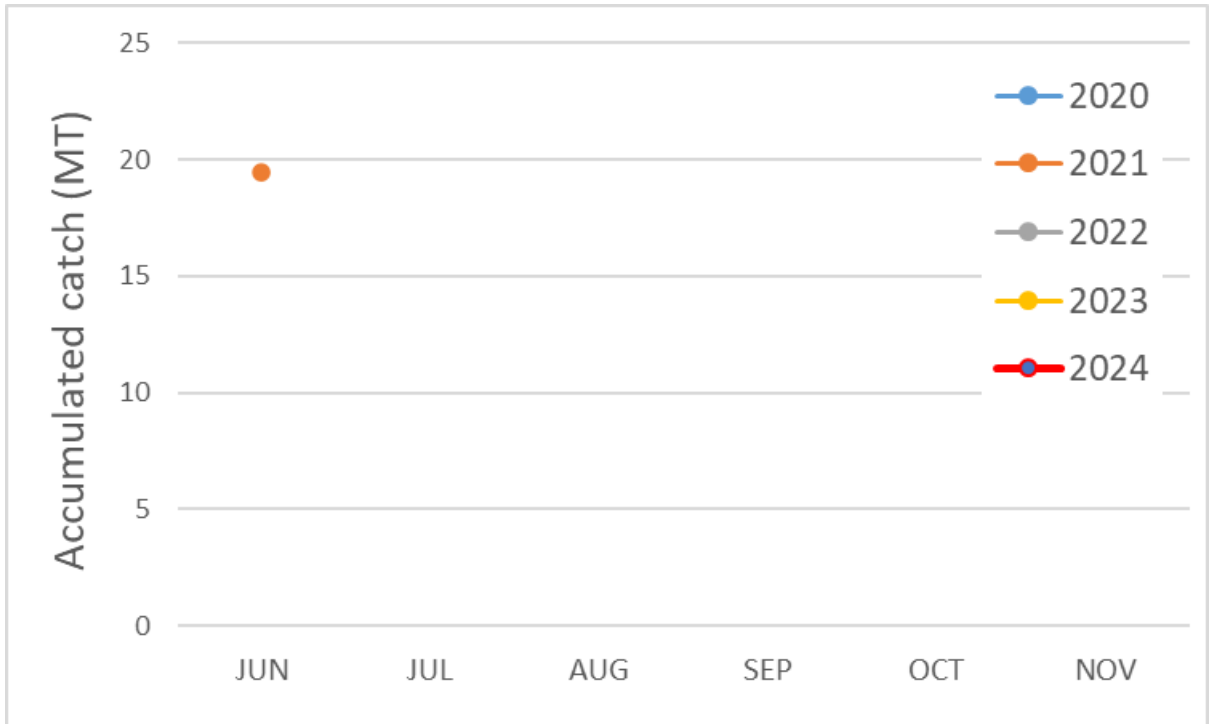
- There was one vessel in the eastern region between 2016 and 2024

Accumulated catch

West of 170°E



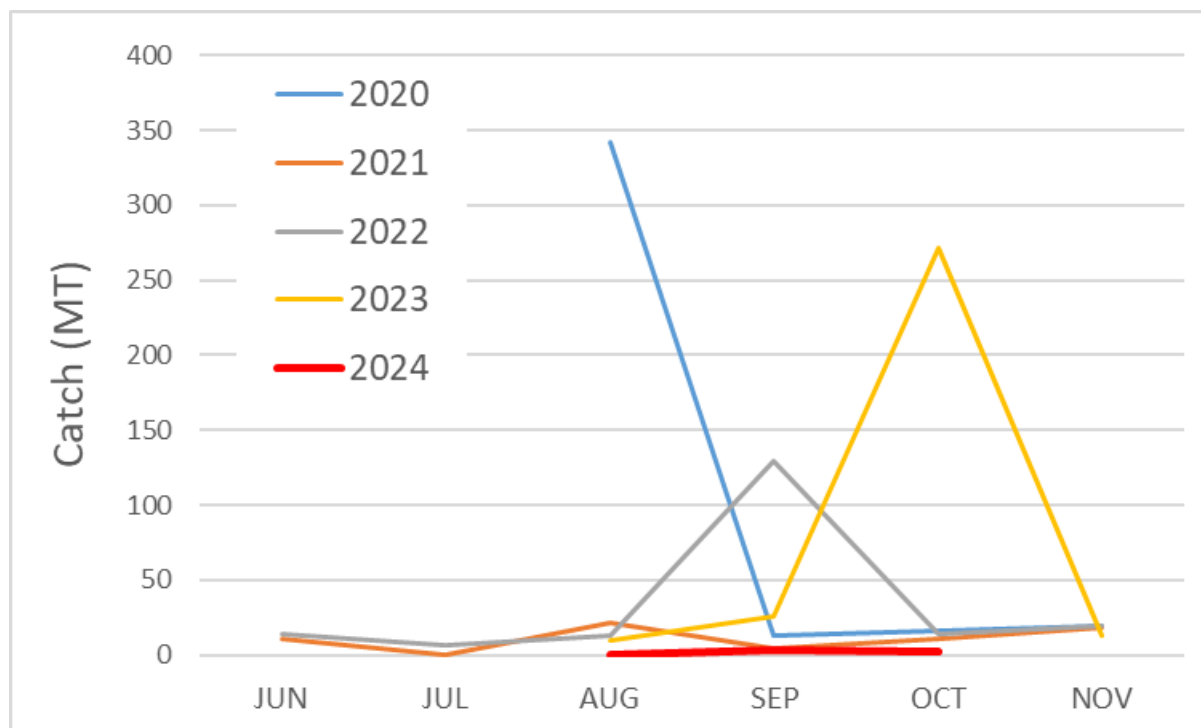
East of 170°E



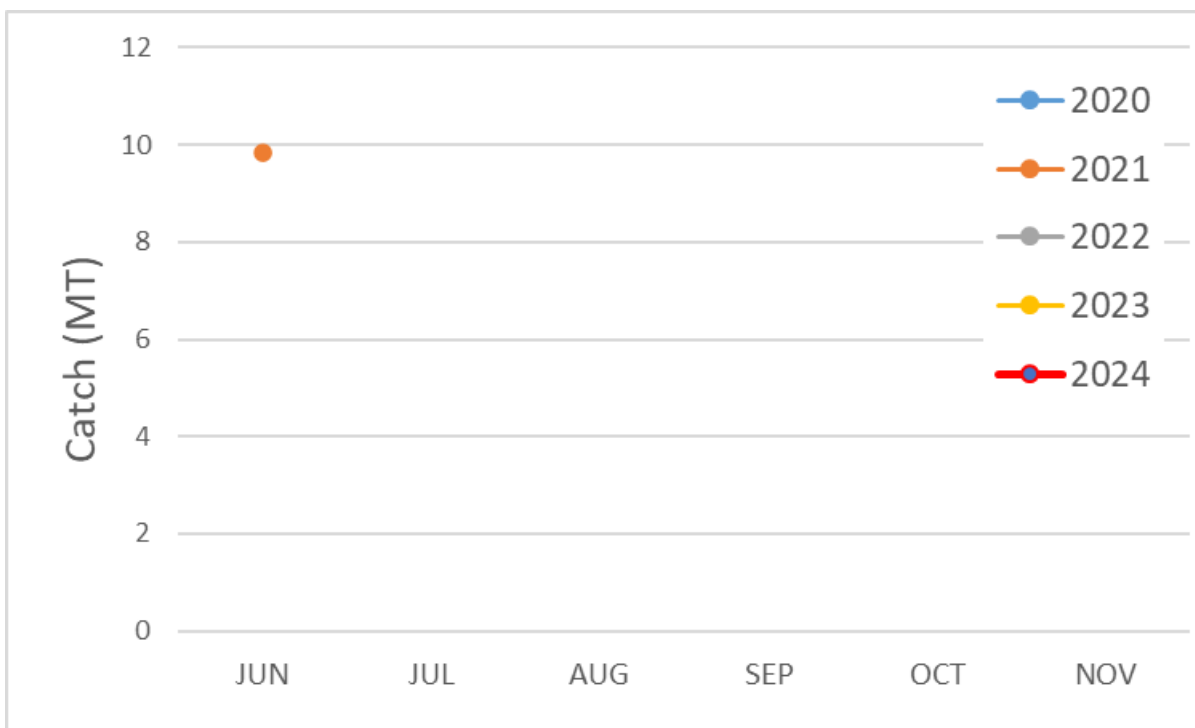
- In 2024, only seven vessels operated temporarily from August to October

West of 170°E

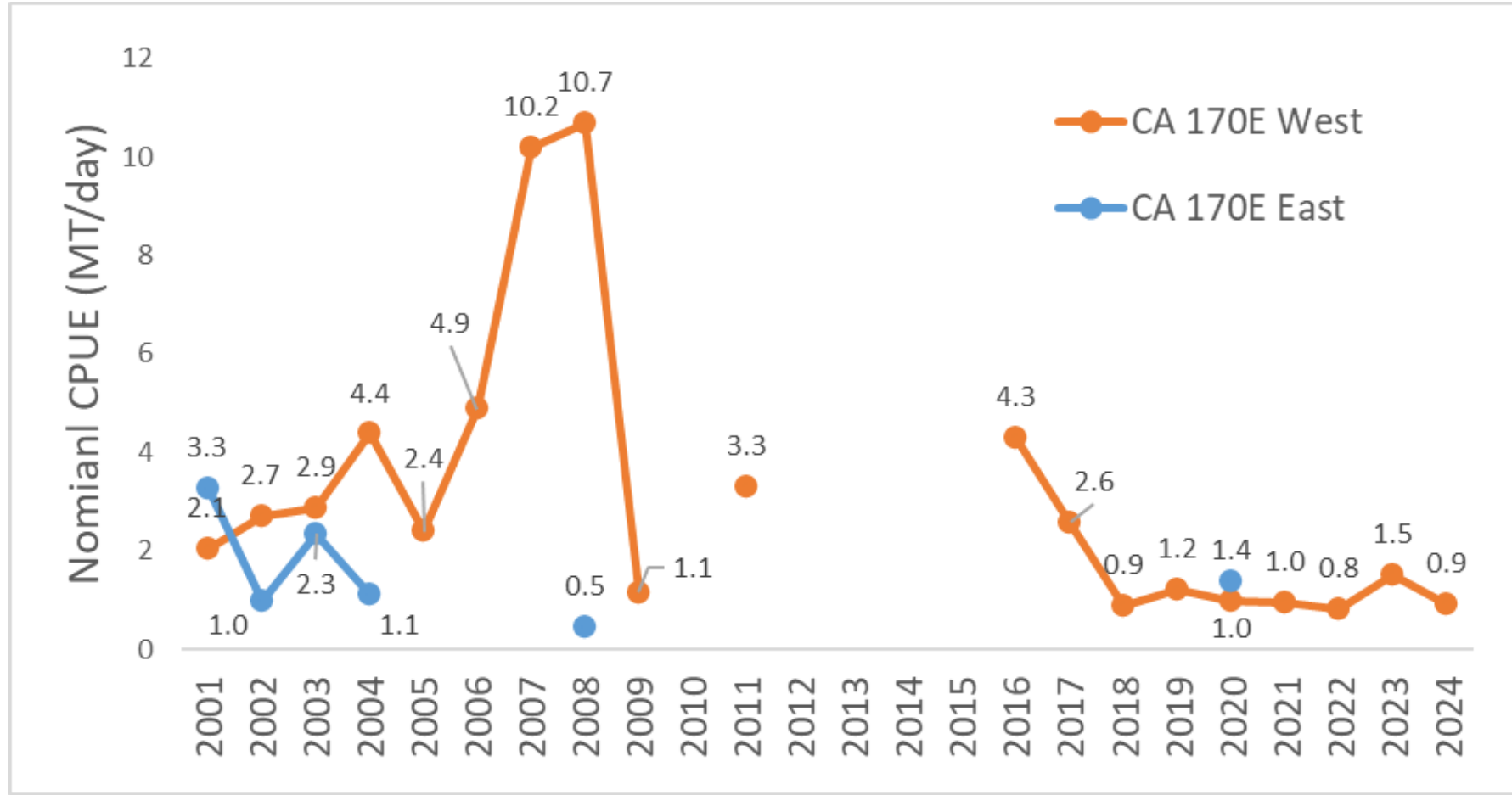


East of 170°E



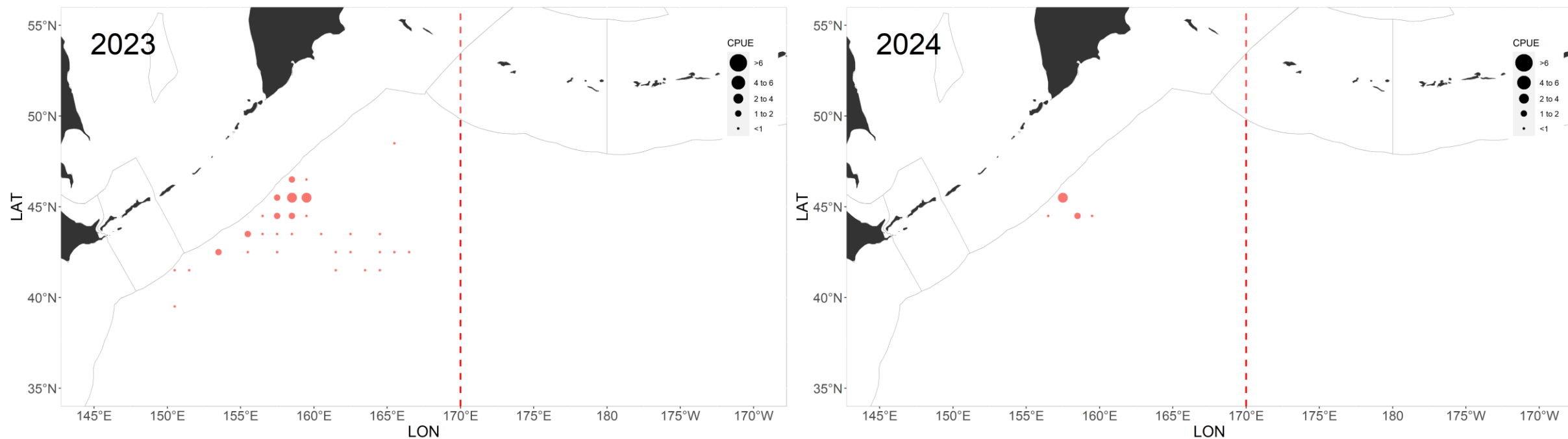
- The total catch was 6.5 tons in 2024

Nominal CPUE



- Nominal CPUE is higher in western region

Spatial nominal CPUE



- The fishing grounds in 2024 was smaller than those in 2023

Summary

- Neon flying squid fishery in 2024
 - A total of seven vessels involved in the fishery, with a catch of 6.5 tons
- The nominal CPUE was 0.93 tons /day in 2024
