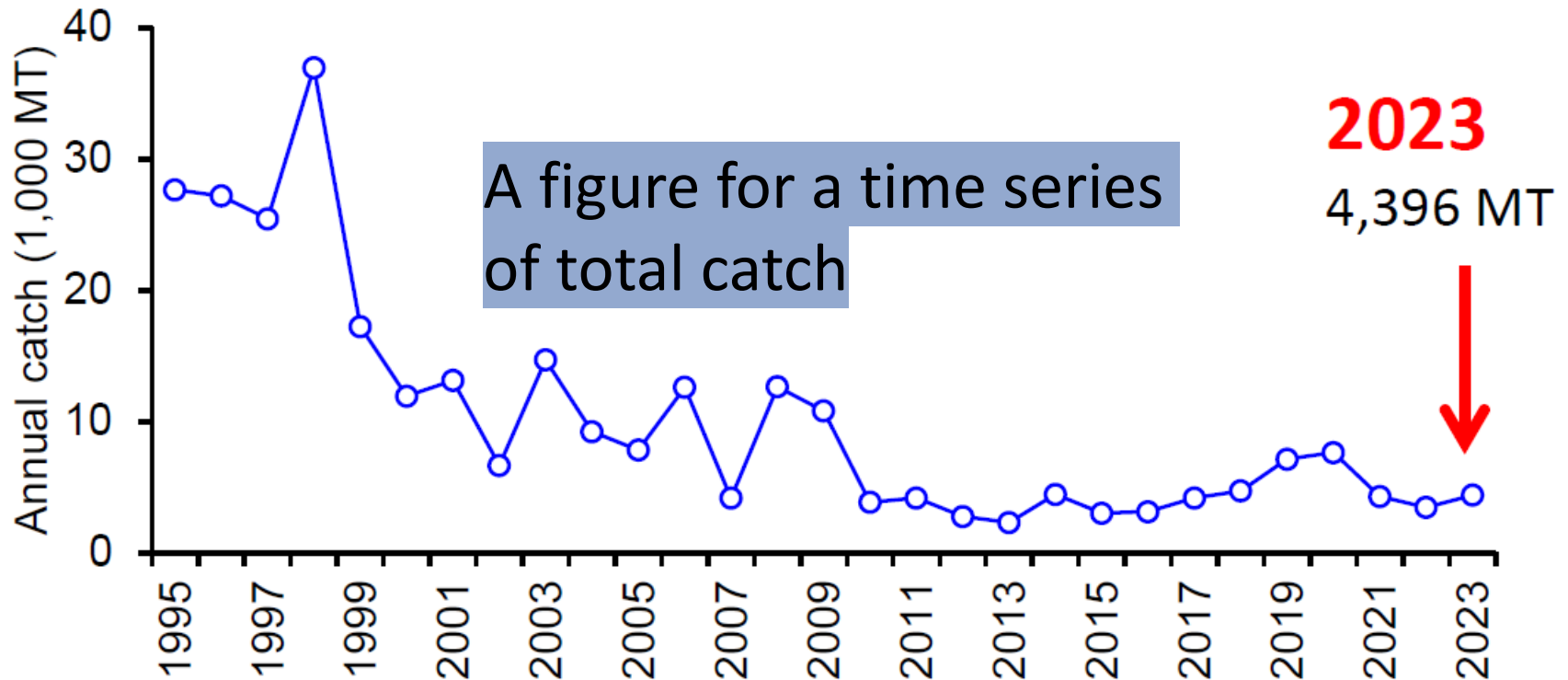

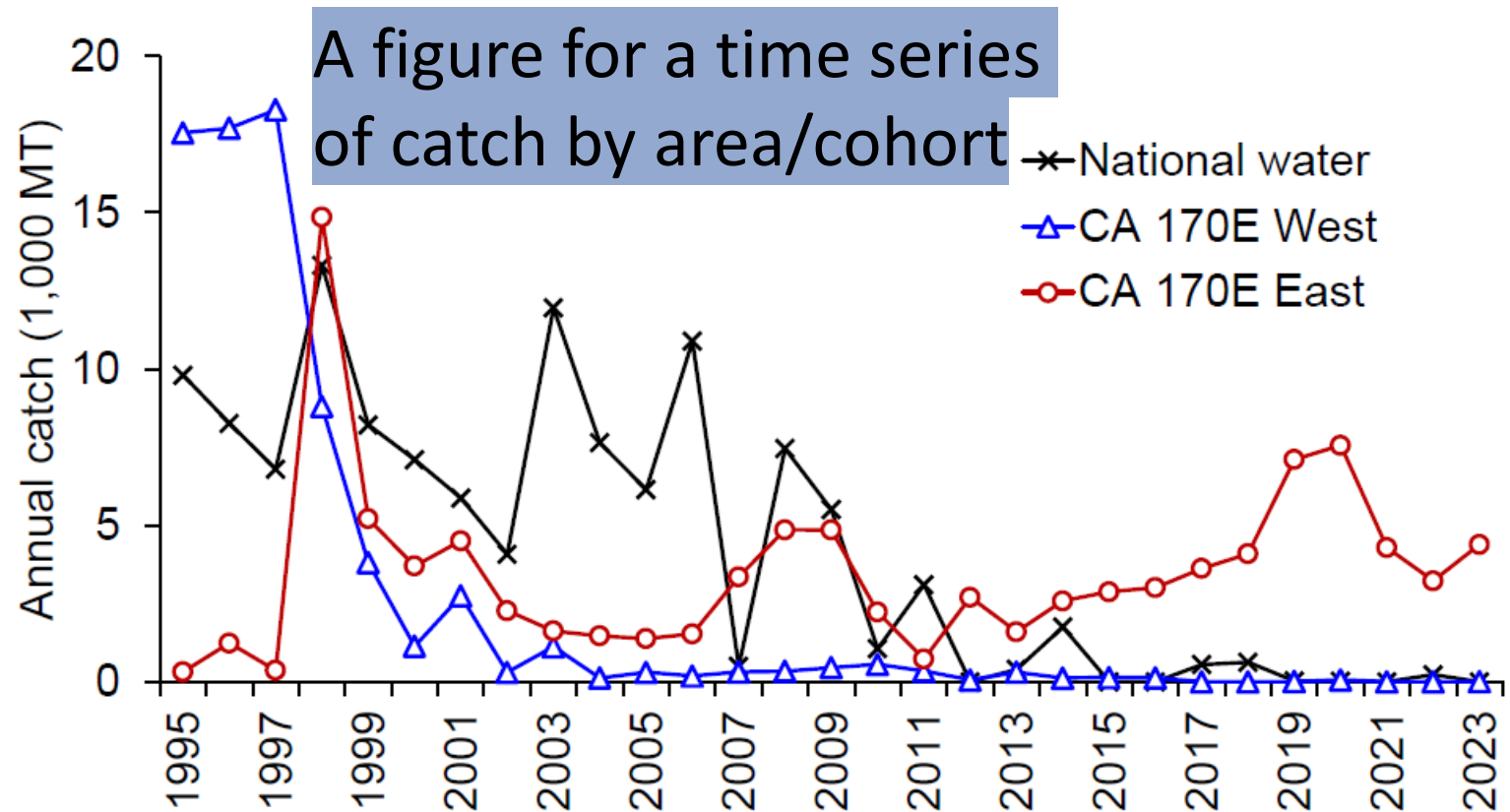

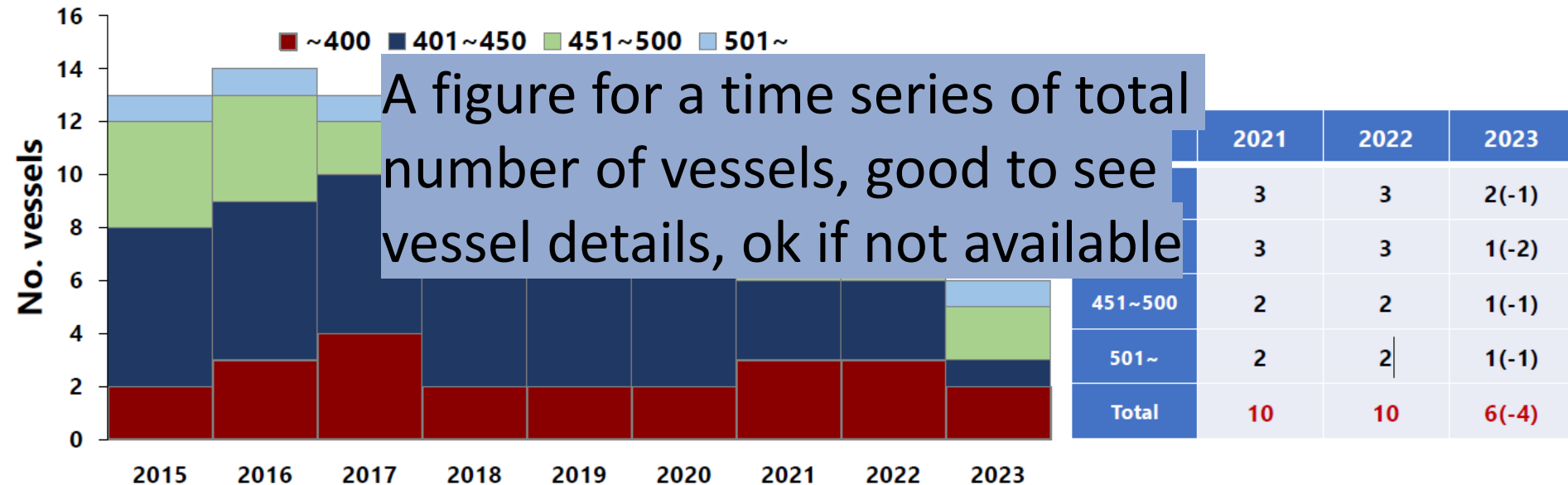

Annual catch by area/cohort



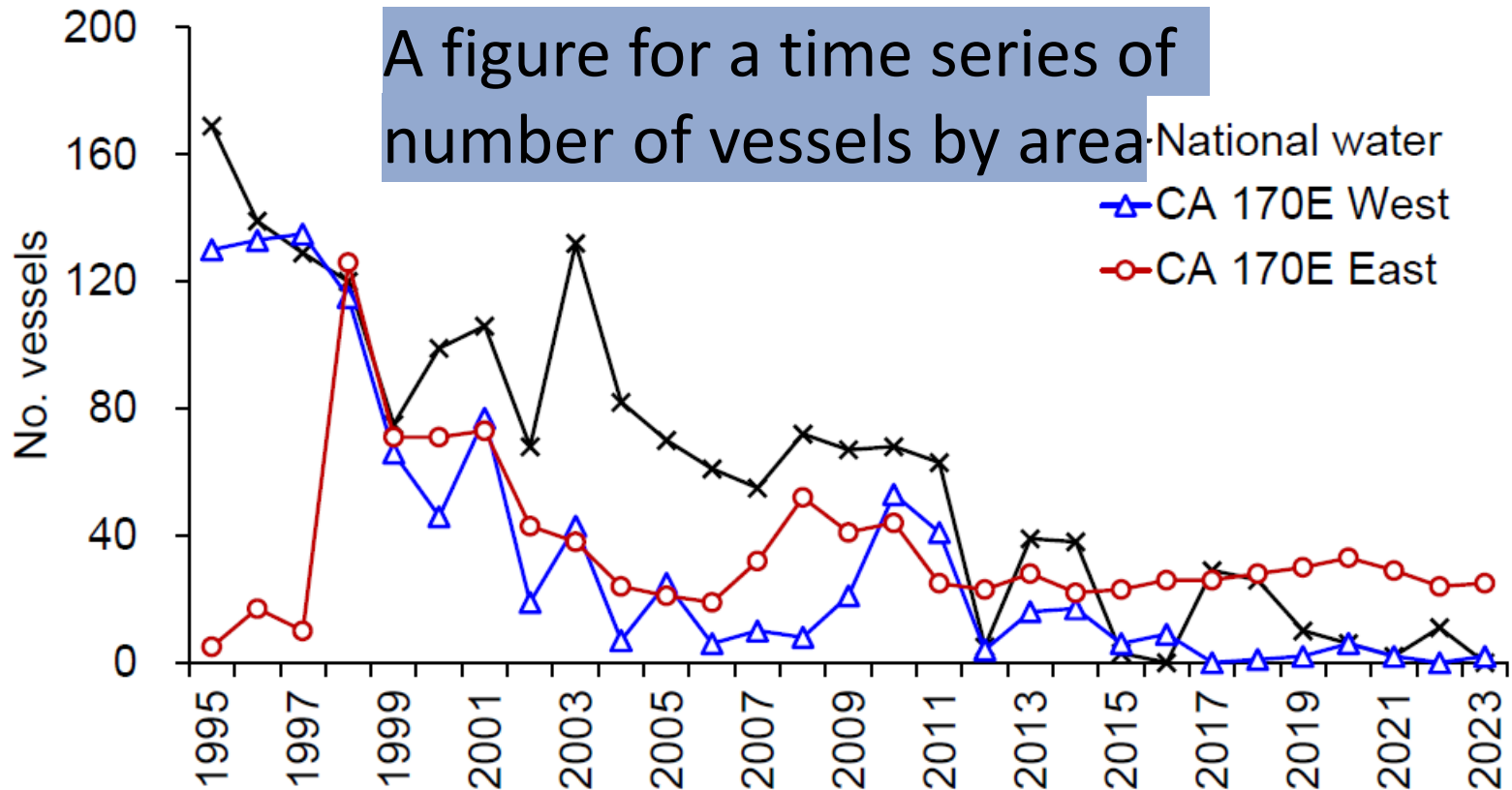

Number of vessels by area

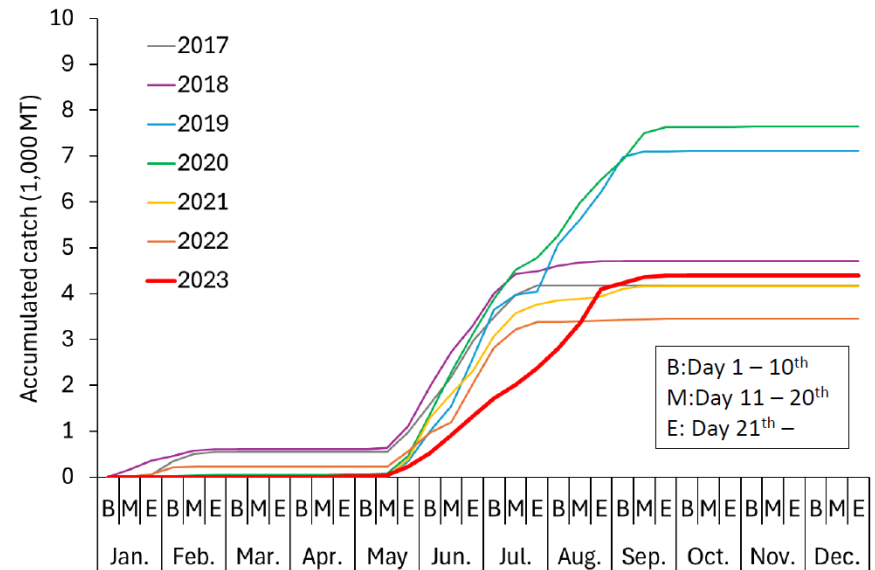
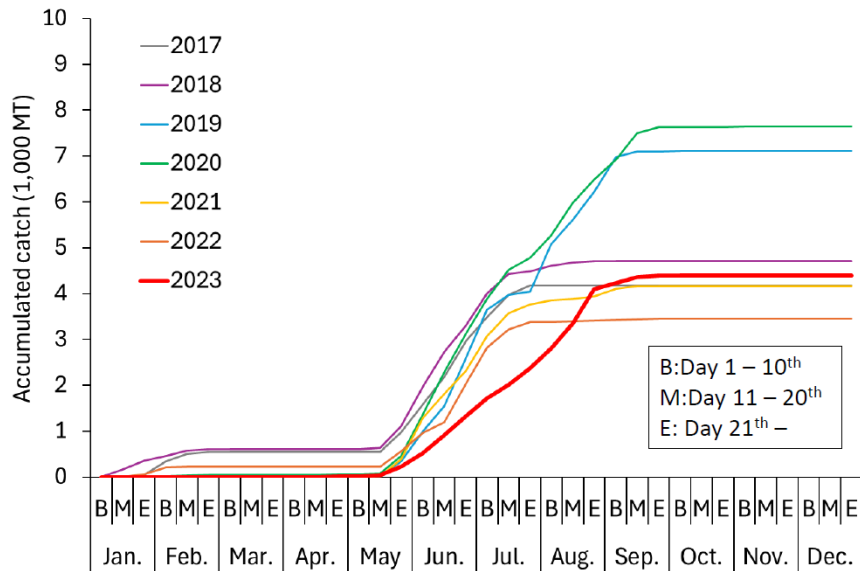

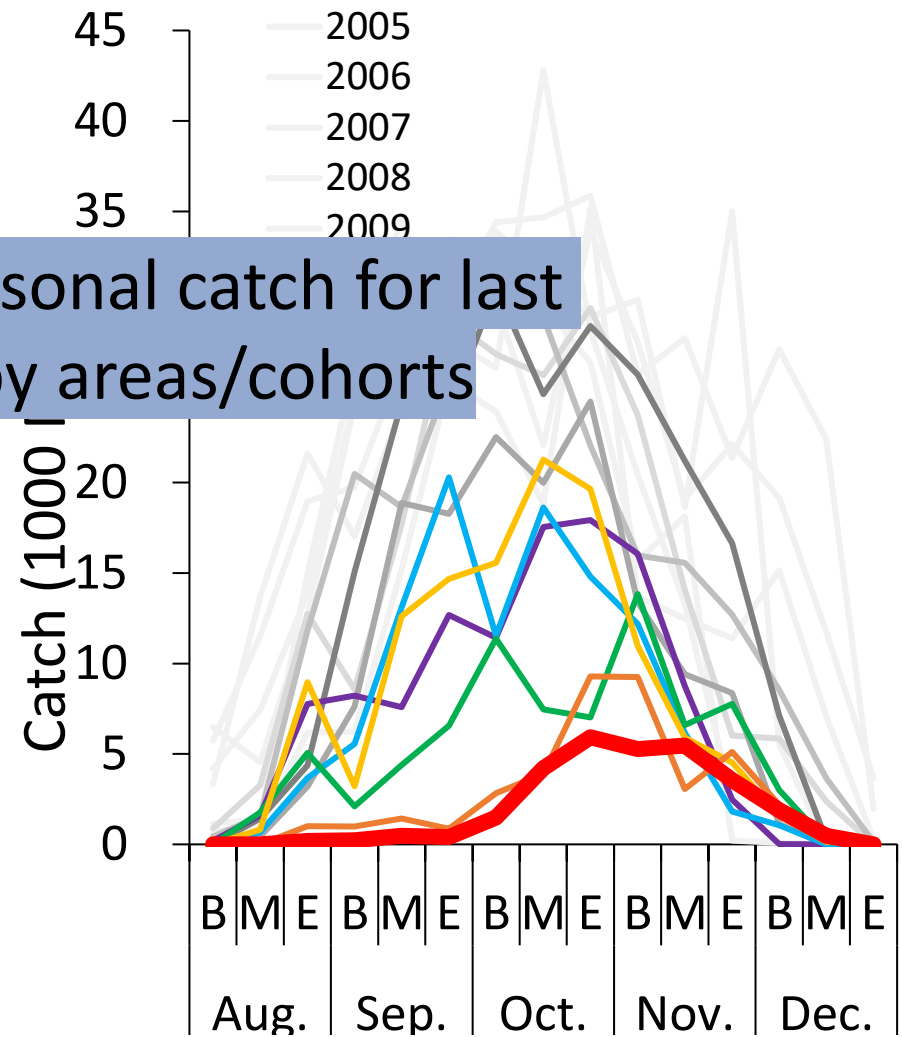
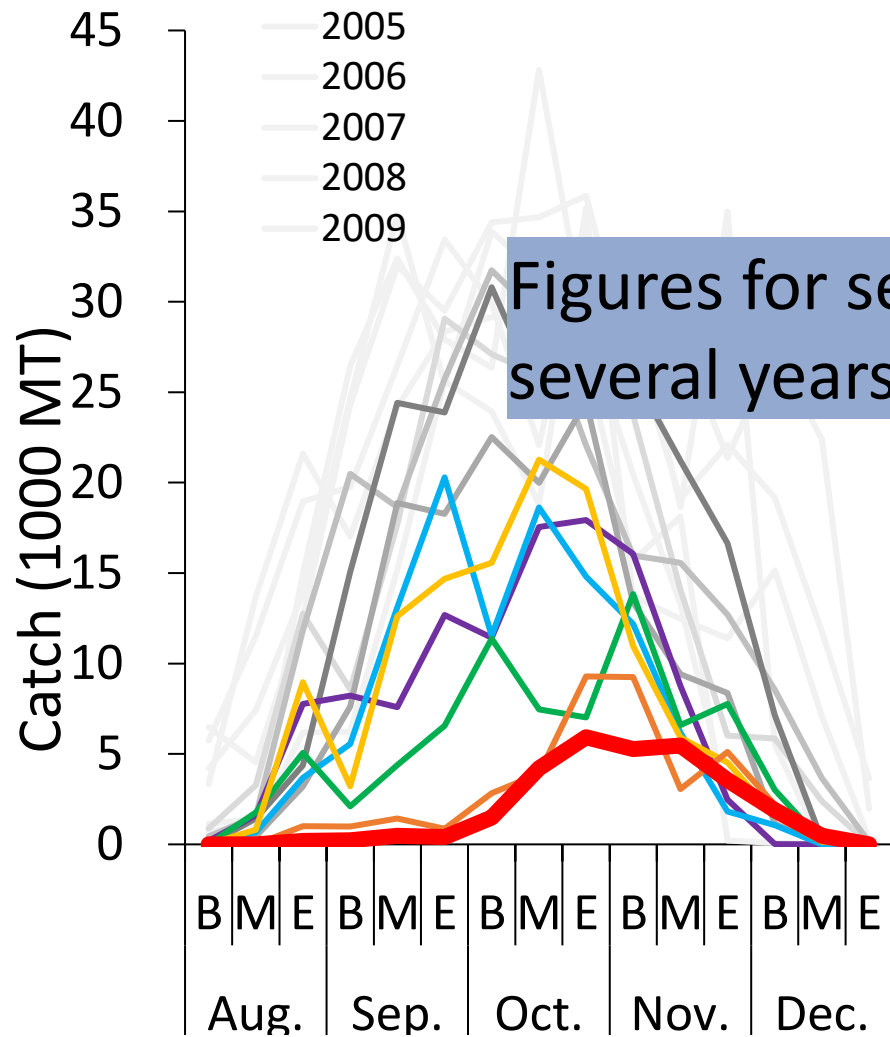
Figures for accumulated catch for last several years by areas/cohorts

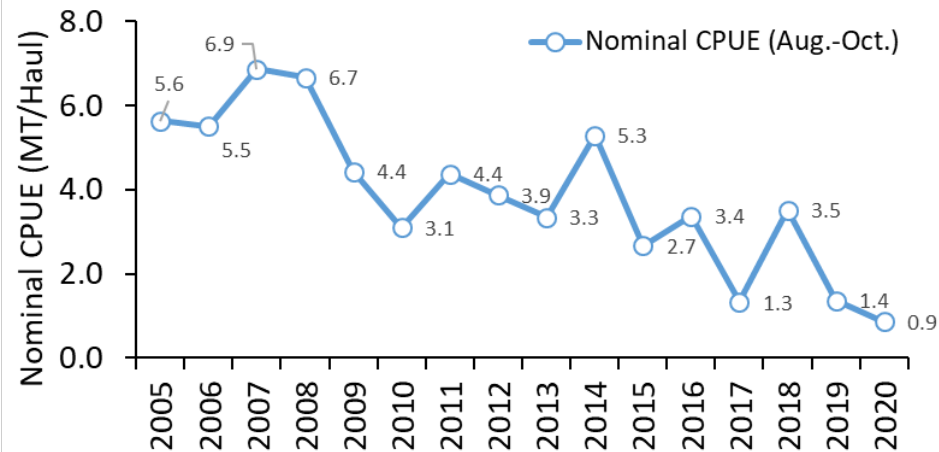
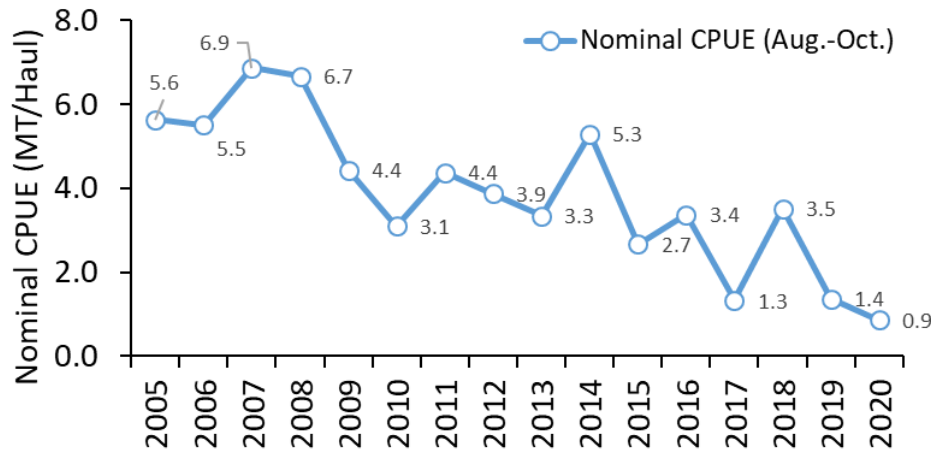
Seasonal catch
